- School Assessment Data for the Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (F.A.S.T.) Test
 - Resources such as F.A.S.T. practice tests are available on www.fffast.org. The Parent Portal also offers some helpful resources as well.
 - ◆ Mr. Johnson went to the F.A.S.T. Test website and showed parents how to access the practice tests and how students must get used to using the online calculators. There are only 88 days left until testing.
 - ◆ Mr. Johnson also stated that he is willing to send a practice test by grade level to parents.
