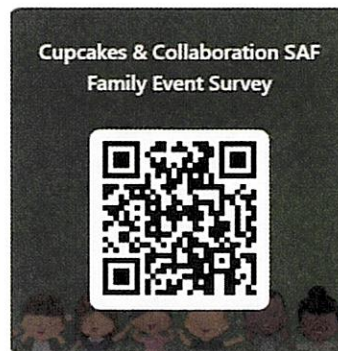

SAF Meeting Minutes

10/29/25

Meeting called to order at 6:15pm by Ms. LaPorte, Assistant Director.

Ms. LaPorte provided parents with an update on the school's performance and ranking amongst the County and State.

SAF By Laws reviewed. Motion to approve was made by Karina Bula and seconded by Neila Atkinson.

SAF Chairperson was not present to provide update.

Mr. Gustavo De Los Santos, AP Computer Science teacher, presented to families the basics and foundation of artificial intelligence (AI). A discussion was held regarding the importance of monitoring students when using the platforms and the positive and negative consequences of AI.

Mrs. Christine Webber, Psychology teacher, presented to families a project she assigned to her students. Students were tasked with using AI to create a paper in APA format and citing sources. Students had to critically analyze the paper that was created and determine if the platform was creating the assignment that was asked. Students had to analyze and report on their findings.

Mrs. Kimberly Fort, School Social Worker, facilitated an activity with the families. Families were shown an example of a prompt using ChatGPT to illustrate how AI can be used to assist in a family. Parents and students were then asked to use an AI platform (ChatGPT, CoPilot, and Gemini were suggested) to create a prompt to solve either a personal or family challenge. One of the prompts had to be asked by the student (child) and one had to be asked by the parent (adult). Families were then encouraged to share their prompt and response with the group.

The meeting ended at 7:50pm with a feedback survey on the meeting and survey for parents to detail how they would like to be involved in activities on campus.
