Ernie Lozano- Task Assigned, Chief Safety Officer

Discussion of Metal Detectors- now at ALL high schools in the county

Random Wandering- 4 classrooms at each location chosen Once chosen removed from pool so not selected multiple times

K9 program is starting soon. This will detect drugs and weapon with partnership of local PD's

Closing front perimeters and improving surveillance is the current area of focus. No extra security will be hired to man these enclosed front gates. Current staff will man it, and only lock when they must walk away.

Possibility of metal detectors and Middle and Elementary.

Concerns were discussed about severe and dangerous traffic at Nova HS, public announcements not fully functional at some schools, and that lightning and weather alerts are not functioning at all schools.

Records request custodian is not responding to multiple requests.

PANIC Buttons have been purchased, and all staff and substitutes will have them next school year. These start an immediate lockdown response and police are contacted. The button can also be used for medical and altercations.

Bullying is not being addressed properly. Mr. Lazano looking into it.

Classes resume January 6th. The planning day is moved to January 10th. Teachers are not supposed to be assigning work over break.

Natalie Lynch-Walsh- Audit, Facilities Task Force, District Advisory Report

The schools at MLK and Broward Estates have very low occupancy. Combining these schools will allow for increased student services. Broward Estates was built in 1957, needs extensive repairs and code upgrades.

The boundary committee voted against the proposal that was given to them.
