**MINUTES**

Meeting called to order at 4:15.

1. Legislative Update: please see the newest handout. Our legislative rep Nikki Watkins has condensed all the newest updates. This sessions focus is safety, student support and academic programming. SB 1216 deals with teacher compensation. SB 1296 changes in union certification.
2. District Update: 60 district staff members have been deployed to schools. 200 positions are grant funded and restricted by grant requirements. 30 individuals remain available for deployment. Concerns raised for long term solutions and how pulling staff will impact other roles. Question as whether ESE, support facilitators and critical roles being reassigned. Request for clarification on hiring freeze applicable to security staff. Facilities update: 5 year plan in place. Priority ranking system in place since 2019. Some work orders exceed 495 days. Stakeholders request number of urgent work orders. Moisture, Asbestos and Water testing. State law requires testing of 20% of schools for water quality. Mold concerns require an Indoor Air Quality (IAQ) assessment request can be submitted by administration. Physical Education Policy: draft policy available on DAC website. Scheduled for board consideration in March or April. <https://browarddistrictadvisory.ch2v.com/>
3. Budget, SAC, AICE/AP funds: questionnaire sent to principals regarding required testing funds. Moving forward allocating funds based on need rather than automatic rollover of student earned AP/AICE funds. Stakeholders are holding committee's regarding loss of funding for these classes.
4. Food & Nutrition: student balances being put on their obligations. Families are encouraged to contact F&N regarding outstanding balances and payment plans.
