Who Can Join???

Youth between the ages of 6 - 18 years old.

(6-year-olds) must be in 1st grade.

ALL MEMBERSHIPS EXPIRE AUGUST 6, 2025

ALL MEMBERS MUST BRING THEIR CLUB CARD EVERY DAY OR PAY \$1.00 TO BUY A NEW ONE!

- There will be a \$5.00 per child charge for the first 15 minutes you are late and a \$1.00 per child fee for every minute late thereafter.
- Law enforcement will be called if you are over 30 minutes late in picking up your child.
