MINUTES

Intro: As SAF chair, I am here to communicate concerns, interests and recommendations between stakeholders, the school and our Regional Advisory Council. As stakeholders we can work in collaboration with our administrators. An example is help build community partnerships/ fundraising to help offset costs that our budget no longer allows.

Voting in our new By-Laws: brief overview of By-Laws. All attendees votes Yes for 2026-2027 By-Laws as they are presented.

Hot topics around the District:

1. FOCUS: issue with changing updating contact form. Media form – opt in our out on Focus. You don't have the ability to pick and choose. Changing and updating contact form must be done in person at your child's school. SPHS sent home a paper copy of this contact form for parents to update and turn into office.
2. Transportation: Who is our School Liason? Ms. Miller is the magnet liason. Post in Paladin Newsletter next year for parents. Certain stops have been taken away. Buses are late or not showing up at all. Some buses have kids sitting on the floor. Why can't the Where's my Bus APP start working first day of school? Not everyone has the ability to drive their kids to school.
3. Food & Nutrition: Meals not being served that are on the menu. Running out of food. Kids with certain food restrictions are unable to eat. Forms for special dietary needs must be processed yearly. Remind parents that special diets even when noted in the IEP – brings doctors note to AP then follow up with Café manager.
4. Class Size: Core classes over the 25 limit. Not enough lap tops or chairs. The district has never actually been fined so will we get any relief when the deadline to meet class size quota comes along?
