Minutes

- **Welcome:**
 - The meeting was called to order by Ms. Baptiste at 5:30 pm and seconded by Mr. Larkin. Ms. Baptiste welcomed the committee and guests to the first meeting.
- **Selection of SAC Members:**
 - Ms. Baptiste will serve as the SAC Chair, Ms. Graves will serve as the SAC Co-Chair, Ms. Genette Cenor will serve as the ESE representative, Mr. Will Mendez will serve as the ESOL representative, Ms. Wendy Casanova will serve as the Gifted representative, and Ms. Caryn Campbell will serve as the BTU representative. Ms. Baptiste reviewed the roles and responsibilities of each position for each member and asked the committee and guests for volunteers for the remainder of positions available.
- **Approval of May 2025 Minutes & Bylaws**
 - Ms. Baptiste reviewed the May 2025 SAC/SAF minutes and the Bylaws for 2025-2026 School year. Ms. Baptiste asked

for questions or asked for approval of both. Ms. Campbell seconded the approval of both.

- **2025 - 2026 School Improvement Plan:**

- Ms. Reynolds shared that state of the school regarding the School Improvement Plan and “What’s new with AWE”.

- **Principal’s Report:**

Ms. Reynolds discussed the following items:

- K-5 students began iReady Reading and will resume with Math this week.
- FAST PM1:
 - K-2 Sept. 8th and 11th
 - Grade 3 Reading: Sept. 9th & Grade 4 and 5: Sept. 10th
 - Grade 3-5 Math: Sept. 3rd
- AWE is now a “B” rated school. We reviewed last year’s proficiency scores, goals for 25 - 26 SY, the Problem of Practice and areas for improvement: Math Proficiency and increasing ESE proficiency in both Reading and Math.
- The goal is to increase to 60% in all areas by the Spring FAST PM3 assessment in May 2026.
- Shared on the decrease of student enrollment at AWE / Broward County on a whole.
- ASD population at AWE has increased and is growing.
- All staff members were trained and have received panic badges.
- Budget: decreased staff by two positions that were not presently filled, so there was no loss of current instructional staff.

- New Staff: Atlantic West welcomes 11 new staff members both instructional and noninstructional, including assistant principal, Ms. Corrine Mendez, and guidance counselor, Natasha Maxon.
- **Accountability Fund \$21,271.16**
 - Ms. Reynolds explained what the Accountability Fund is used for and how it is allocated for our school. Last year, funds were used to purchase a laminator and poster maker.
- **School Environment Safety Incident Report (SESIR) - 0**
 - Ms. Reynolds identified the 13 event types (bullying, vaping, fighting, threats, etc.) and notified the committee that we currently had zero incidents.
