

Welcome:

A meeting of the Horizon Elementary School Advisory Council was called to order at 2:15 PM. Ms. Edmund welcomed everyone. Introduced herself as the SAC Chairperson and Mrs. Lohsen Tucker as the SAC Secretary.

Review of September 25, 2025 meeting

Mrs. Tucker reviewed meeting minutes. No questions were raised.

Work of the School Advisory Council (SAC)/SIP/Monitoring and Data Analysis

Ms. Edmund shared the function of Horizon's SAC, purpose of the School Improvement Plan, and SIP Monitoring. to the stakeholders present. Ms. Edmund also shared our school K-5 data and our area of focus for our current SIP. Mrs. Wilson also shared our plan on how we are meeting the needs of our students in order to maintain our "A" status.

City of Sunrise Police: School Zone Camera Information

Officer Daniel Ransone shared the new speed program that is currently in permitting and should be instituted in January of 2026. Its purpose is to change driver behaviors as well as increase student and staff safety. Several meetings have been held in the community to raise awareness as well as mailings, social media, and they will also have flyers to give our parents in the car loop. There was also a time for questions and answers. Office Ransone will also return for our 2 parent holiday shows to share with a larger audience.

Principal's Report/Budget Update

Mr. Smith celebrated/reviewed our 2024-2025 data and our "A" status. He shared our school report card. Due to our "A" status, Horizon has received School Recognition Funds. Proposals will be submitted with a final ballot to vote on in January. We must complete this prior to February so that our funding is not lost.

Mr. Smith spoke of the loss of funding due to the loss of students in Broward County. Luckily, we have not lost any teachers as in summer, he was careful in how many teachers he hired for openings. Unfortunately, if enrollment remains the same or decreases again in 2026, we may have to lose a special teacher, a custodian, and/or office staff.

Mr. Smith shared information regarding School Accountability Funds=\$8,000. In an effort to reach on of our academic goals, Mr. Smith proposed using \$3,200 to pay for ELO (Extra Learning Opportunities) to hold an afterschool science camp for our 5th grade students. Motion to approve from Ms. Slyker. Seconded by Mrs. Tucker. Approved.

Title I Report

Mrs. Tucker shared that both she, and Ms. Dennique Moodie are the Title I Liaisons for the 2025-2026 school year. At this time, there was nothing to share.

Composition Update

Ms. Edmund/Mr. Smith shared the recruiting of our new SAC members. Members were introduced and a motion was made to approve by Mrs. Tucker. Ms. Edmund seconded. Approved. Ms. Edmund will update so we are in compliance with our SAC composition.

School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR)

Ms. Edmund shared the meaning of SESIR. Currently, Horizon has 7 incidents on file and 25 discipline referrals at this time. All of our required drills, documentation is in order. Mr. Smith did clarify that some of our incidents involve a particular student and that he will soon meet all criteria to attend a behavior change school.
