## School Advisory Council (SAC) Meeting Agenda

Wednesday – January 28, 2026

3:15 PM in the Media Center

1. Meeting Called to Order, Introductions, Attendance (determine if a quorum is present)

-Meeting was called to order by Mr. Wells at 3:23pm. Ms. Maria waws first to motion. Ms. Marcelin second the motion.

2. Approval of December Meeting Minutes

- Mr. Wells went over the meeting minutes from the previous meeting. No motions were made for any corrections to be made. Ms. Maria motioned for the minutes to be approved. Ms. Rodriguez seconded. Minutes from the December meeting were approved.

3. Assistant Principal Report- Mrs. McNabb

- School Data

- Ms. McNabb discussed the attendance Report with parents highlighting Flamingo’s 94.4% attendance rate from August 11- November 21, 2025 as well as the 92.7% attendance rate from December 1- January 28, 2026. Mc. McNabb explained to parents that typically the attendance rate does have a slight decline in December and January due to the holidays and travel plans as well as the raised right of illness that is typical during those months. Ms. McNabb reiterated that it is vital for students to attend school every day.

-Ms. McNabb went over Flamingo Elementary’s Academic Goals for the 2025-2026 school year. The goals are as follows:

Ms. McNabb went over how after school tutoring will be happening this year and why the group of students that were invited were identified academically. (see bullet point #6 for breakdown)

- Recognition Fund / School Accountability (Funds plan)
  - Ms. McNabb also went over the School Accountability Funds plan which breaks down as follows:
    - School Accountability: \$6235.00
    - School Recognition Funds: \$1797.00

Ms. McNabb asked SAC to vote on using funds toward salaries for 10 teachers to host ELO Camp. Ms. Smith motioned to approve the plan. Ms. Maria seconded. Motion carried. Plan was approved to using funds towards teacher salaries that are hosting ELO camp.

#### 4. School Improvement Plan 2025-2026

- Review School Improvement Plan 2025-2026
  - Ms. McNabb discussed the Parent Compact for Flamingo Elementary. A sample of the new format was given to parents to look over. Ms. McNabb discussed the change from one plan per grade level to one universal plan for all Flamingo students. Any grade specific items will be addressed in that grade level during back to school discussions.
- Development Title 1 Addendum (Parent Input) 2026-2027
  - Parents feel our plan encompasses all the needs of our students. Ms. McNabb reviewed some initiatives in places to support and attain our School Improvement focus goals. She discussed the W.I.N. time to assist our lowest quartile students in Reading and Math through additional small group support Monday through Thursday for 30 minutes. Ms. McNabb also discussed the Extended Learning Camps for Reading and Math. No parental Input was given.
- Parent Compact Review and Development 2026 – 2027 (Parent Input)
- Parent Engagement Plan
  1. Review old plan and Parent Input on NEW plan for 2026-2027 school year
    - Ms. McNabb discussed Math Night at CJ Blacks coming up on February 23, 2026. Students/families will come out to CJ Blacks and receive math problems based on the menu provided by the restaurant. New problems were created for this year to challenge the students that also participated last year. Homework passes will be awarded to the students who complete the worksheet at the restaurant.
    - Book Fair is coming to Flamingo Elementary beginning March 24, 2026. Family Night at the Book fair will be Tuesday, March 24, 2026. Special activities at the book fair this year will include a coloring station, a special

appearance and read-a-long with Plato from Publix (still being discussed) and shopping with the new Flamingo Elementary flamingo mascot.

-Parents were happy with offerings and would like to brainstorm more ways to get the community involved in activities. This will be an ongoing discussion topic.

2. Development/Discussion of Allocation of Funds for 2026-2027 school year

-Ms. McNabb stated that this year we are using the funds for afterschool tutoring camps targeting our level 2 students that can achieve a level 3 on the F.A.S.T. test at the end of the year- Flamingo would like to plan on using the funds in the same manner next year. No suggestions for next year were given.

5. SESIR (School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting)- Mrs. McNabb

- Ms. McNabb informed the group that Flamingo has 13 referrals school wide to date. It was discussed that the majority of these are the same small group of students. Ms. McNabb reiterated that students at Flamingo are respectful and well behaved to which she attributes to the low number of referrals and behavior issues. She extended her thanks and appreciation to the families for supporting Flamingo by reminding their students of the importance of positive behavior.

6. Flamingo Elementary F.A.S.T Data Comparison

-Data comparison for F.A.S.T. PM2 was discussed highlighting Flamingo’s growth in Math, 34% of our students are achieving a level 3 or higher this year on the PM2 test compared to 32% from last year at this time. Reading is staying strong and comparable to previous years with 42% of our students currently at a level 3 or higher compared to 43% from last year. Teachers and Administrators are confident that the students will continue to grow and will be able to achieve the goals needed to maintain the A grade awarded to the school last year

-F.A.S.T. ELA (Reading) and Math Lowest Quartile comparisons were discussed and that data was used to identify the students that were selected for ELO camp. Flamingo data for lowest quartile is as follows:

7. Title 1 – Survey Results

-the Title 1 survey was given to 10 randomly selected classrooms and we received 85 responses. 60 responses were required to have valid results. The results of the survey show:

71% of our parents receive information from the school about their child's test scores.

78% said they feel that the teachers, admin, and school staff communicate with them.

83% say they know how to contact their child's teacher.
