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## 1. SAF Report

Meeting called to order by Mr. Wells at 3:22p.m. Ms. Smith was first to motion; Ms. Maria second the motion.

Mr. Wells went over the current hiring freeze within Broward County Public Schools. Future vacancies will be filled by District personnel to accommodate the hiring freezes. As of now, Flamingo Elementary has no open vacancies.

Broward County Public Schools 1 to 1 laptop distribution has started. Flamingo Elementary has received the laptops that will be distributed once inventoried into the system. Parent links with more information will be sent in the near future.

47 schools within the district do not have a nurse on campus assigned to the school. Flamingo is very fortunate and grateful to have Nurse Olga assigned to us. When a field trip comes up and a nurse is needed- Mrs. Fischer coordinates with student services and the school is able to have a nurse attend the field trip for the students that need medical attention.
