School Advisory Council (SAC) Meeting

Wednesday – March 25, 2026

1. Meeting Called to Order, Introductions, Attendance (determine if a quorum is present)

Meeting was called to order at 3:22pm by Mr. Wells. Ms. Marcelin moved the motion and Mrs. Maria seconded.

2. Approval of February Meeting Minutes

Mr. Wells discussed the meeting minutes from February's SAC meeting and asked everyone to review for any changes. Mrs. Smith motioned approving the minutes from February. Mrs. McIntyre seconded the motion. Previous meeting minutes were approved.

3. Principal Report- Mrs. DeGreeff

- Ms. DeGreeff opened her report by thanking everyone that came out to Flamingo Elementary in support of the Scholastic Book Fair Family Night. The event was a huge success largely in thanks to PTO and Publix for the wonderful collaboration and the activities that were planned for the students and families. Ms. DeGreeff reminded everyone that Grandparents Tea is this Friday at 7:30am
- School Improvement Parent Survey- Ms. DeGreeff reminded everyone in attendance that Flamingo needs 20% of our parent population to complete the survey being sent out via parent link in order to be in compliance.
- Personality Portraits- What props/items students should bring? Ms. DeGreeff discussed the upcoming Spring Personality Picture day for students. Parents are encouraged to allow their student to dress up in any sports or activity related outfit relating to something they enjoy or hobby that they partake in for the picture. Props such as sporting equipment are OK however, we do ask that the student leaves any props with his/her teacher for the day and

no props that could be viewed as threatening be brought to school. Likewise, anything that would resemble a weapon of any kind is not permitted on school grounds. Lastly Ms. DeGreeff asked families to keep any non-uniform outfit school appropriate and to bring a change of clothes to school so their student can change into regulated uniform once the picture was taken.

4. SESIR (School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting)- Mrs. McNabb Ms. McNabb shared that there are no new SESIR events to report with SAC members. Ms. McNabb reported that at the last meeting Flamingo had a total of 20 referrals school wide, and this month we have a total of 22 referrals school wide for the year as of now. We are very proud of the student body here at Flamingo for being such well-behaved and exemplary students.
