School Advisory Council (SAC) Meeting

Wednesday – April 22, 2026

3:15 PM in the Media Center

1. Meeting Called to Order, Introductions, Attendance (determine if a quorum is present) Meeting was called to order at 3:23pm by Mr. Wells. Ms. Maria moved the motion and Mrs. Marcelin seconded. A quorum is not present so no voting can be done at this meeting.
2. Approval of March Meeting Minutes
 - Mr. Wells discussed the meeting minutes from February’s SAC meeting and asked everyone to review for any changes. Since a quorum is not present, no changes can be made at this time, but we will review them again next meeting and vote them in.
3. Principal Report- Mrs. DeGreeff
 - Ms. DeGreeff began her Principal Report by welcoming everyone to the meeting. Ms. DeGreeff informed the attendees that budget meetings are starting to happen for each school and Flamingo is scheduled for May 7th. Once the meetings are held and the budgets are finalized, Ms. DeGreeff will share any changes at the May SAC meeting. Ms. DeGreeff thanked everyone that participated in the Spring Fundraiser and let everyone know that any families that won raffle prizes have received their baskets. The students that won snack/lunch incentives will be receiving their prizes in the next couple of weeks. Ms. DeGreeff reminded families that students are still earning cafeteria incentives for positive cafeteria behavior, as well as grades 3-5 are earning rewards for their preparation for the F.A.S.T. testing. Ms. DeGreeff let the attendees know that testing prep is fully underway and has been for a few weeks at Flamingo. The results so far have been amazing and we are very excited to see our students “show what they know” on their F.A.S.T. testing happening in May. We have full

confidence that the scores will continue to come back strong as they have in past years.

4. SESIR (School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting)- Mrs. McNabb, Intern Principal

- Ms. McNabb is not able to attend this meeting so Ms. DeGreeff will also give this portion. Flamingo has no state reports to report to attendees at this time. Ms. DeGreeff stated that Flamingo did add 2 new referrals this month, however they were not major situations. Year to date Flamingo has 27 referrals. Ms. DeGreeff reassured the parents that if at any point their child requires any discipline from the school, that Flamingo will be in communication immediately with the parent//guardian.
- A parent asked if the school has noticed any improvement in behavior when the student has a mentor in the school. Ms. DeGreeff discussed that the school has a “trusted adult program” at school that allows the students to reach out to any adult they feel comfortable with to discuss anything on their mind. The staff members here at Flamingo do an amazing job at building relationships and trust with our students. This gives the student the security of discussing things that may be bothering them at home and could potentially lead to behavior issues at school. Ms. DeGreeff stated that while we can’t always change things that are happening in a student’s home, communication with the student lets us check in with them regularly and gives them the reassurance that someone here cares.
- Ms. DeGreeff reminded parents that we still need 47 more parents to complete the parent survey. The deadline for completing the survey is May 15th. This survey is a great tool for parents and our community to share any feedback to the school so improvements can be made.

5. Upcoming Flamingo Happenings

- Tomorrow (4/23) is Take Your Child to Work day and we are very excited to welcome all of our guest children to see what a day at Flamingo is like with their parent/guardian. Students that will be absent from school to participate in the day with their parent/guardian, are asked to have the field trip form filled out and returned if not done already so that the absence can be recorded and excused appropriately.
- Veterans Moving Wall Memorial visit is tomorrow. Students in grades K-2 have made posters and will be in the back bus loop waving flags/posters while the moving memorial wall makes it's way past Flamingo Elementary.
- 4/28- Interims will be going home to students that are not making promotion criteria.
- 4/30- Flamingo Elementary proudly presents Peter Pan Jr at 6pm in the auditorium at Western HS. We are very excited and look forward to seeing everyone there!
