Mrs. Greenhauff Reported

- There is a Sunshine Law and Ethics Training (10 minutes for returning members; 45 minutes for new members). Website was shared with all members.
- Volunteer Application for parents: Schools are continuing to encourage parents to volunteer at school events on campus and field trips.
- State funding allocations \$28.4 billion to K-12 education statewide, \$350 is for school safety/security to continue with upgrades.
- School voucher program will continue to expand to all families regardless of income.
- There will be adjustment to all statewide testing to align with the progress monitoring across the state.
- ESE/Special Education will receive increased funding for services, which includes autism support.
- 4,000 teacher vacancies reported statewide as of August 1, 2025

Local/District Updates

- There are teacher and staff shortages which lead to increased class sizes in some schools 133 openly posted instructional teacher positions in BCPS as of August 1, 2025.
- SAF/SAC representatives are encouraged to bring up concerns regarding unmet needs.
- Continue to encourage all stakeholders (parents, teachers, and students) to attend SAC/SAF meetings for their schools.
