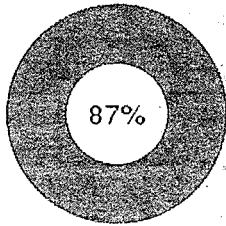

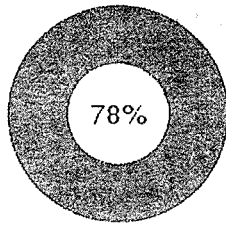

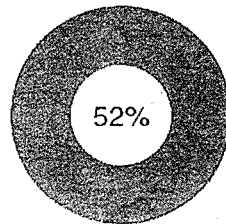

- Members shared several potential ballot options; however, **because quorum was not met, SAC was unable to finalize or vote on any proposals.**
- **A special SAC meeting will be held on December 16, 2025**, specifically to **vote on the creation of the ballot** once quorum is established.

### Historical Ballot Options Presented

Shared by **Ms. Sandoval**:

- **Option 1:** 100% to all staff who worked at least 51% of the school year.
- **Option 2:** 97% to instructional and non-instructional staff, 2% to security, and 1% to cafeteria staff.

### Additional Proposal Shared by Ms. Holligan

- **100% for staff** who worked at least 51% of the **2024–2025** school year and remain employed at the school.

### Staffing Information (Reported by Ms. Fulton)

- Total staff during 2024–2025 school year: **56**
- Staff no longer at the school: **18**
- Instructional staff count (including Head Start, coaches, substitutes): **22**

### Proposed Ballot Options Discussed (Not Voted On)

Although quorum was not met, the following ideas were discussed for future consideration at the December 16th meeting:



- **Option 1:** 100% for staff who worked at least 51% of the 2024–2025 school year and remain at the school.
- **Option 2:** Teachers, Teachers' Aides, and Administrators receive **\$875**, and all other staff receive **\$437.50**.

*These options remain proposals only and will be reviewed and voted on during the December 16th special meeting.*



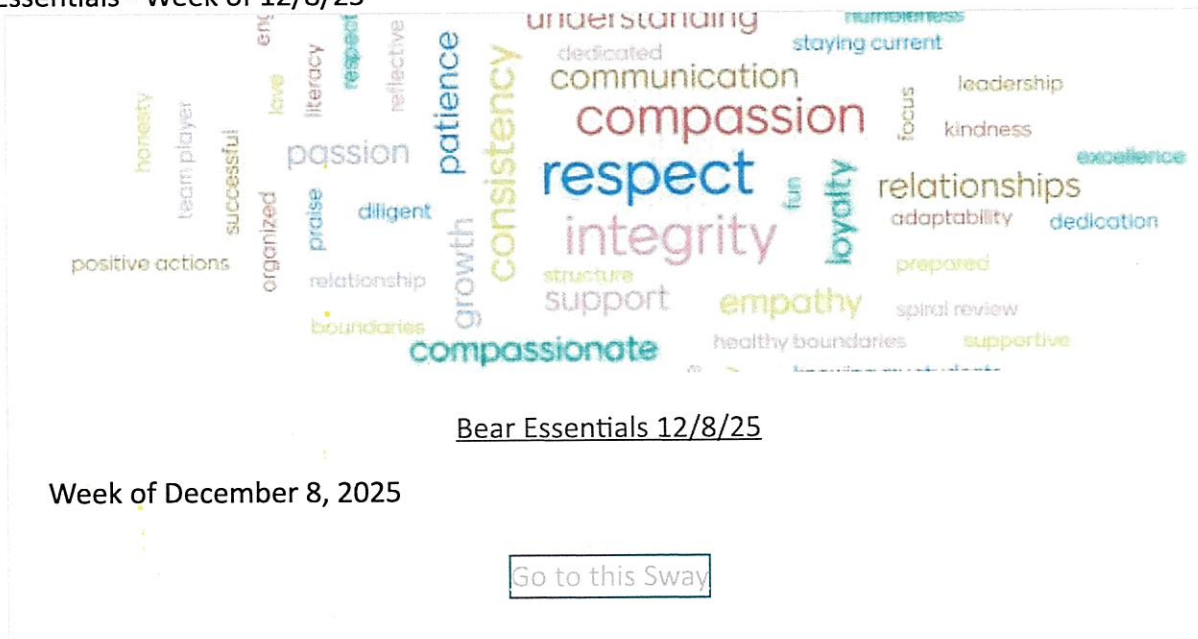

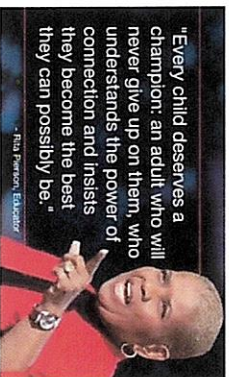

## Centegix Crisis Alert Badge Required Training



As part of our ongoing commitment to enhancing school safety and emergency preparedness, ALL Broward County Public Schools employees have been issued a CrisisAlert Badge. Since the implementation of the Centegix CrisisAlert System there have been numerous inadvertent lockdowns initiated by 8-presses of the CrisisAlert Badge. This has created a situation where police respond to schools expecting an active shooter on campus when no problem exists. As a result, ALL Broward County Public School employees must complete the Crisis Alert Badge/Allyssa's Alert 25-26. This training is essential for ensuring that all employees clearly understand how to utilize and wear the Centegix CrisisAlert Badge correctly.

**ACTION:** The Crisis Alert Badge/Allyssa's Alert 25-26 for ALL employees can be accessed through Learning Across Broward (LAB) and must be completed by **December 19, 2025**. This training will provide participants with the knowledge and skills to properly activate the CrisisAlert Badge to include the 3-press Staff Alert for medical emergencies and the 8-press Lockdown Alert for an active killer, active shooter, active assailant, or visible weapon. To access the Crisis Alert Badge/Allyssa's Alert 25-26 in LAB, please search by the course# 39149957.

## I-Ready Monitoring

Please ensure you are checking your students' I-Ready reports at least weekly. As you review each student's progress, please pay close attention to the following:

- **Domain Settings:**
  - Verify that all domains are turned on unless you have made a strategic instructional decision to turn a domain off. If a domain was turned off, ensure that you are regularly monitoring student progress to confirm the student has not exceeded grade-level expectations in the active domains.

- **Students Working Above Grade Level:**
  - Any student who is performing **beyond their current grade level in math** should be moved back to grade level in the math pathway.
  - For reading, students who are significantly beyond grade level should engage in **teacher-assigned close reading lessons** that build comprehension and deeper analysis. Students doing close reading should only be expected to pass one lesson a week.
- **Minutes and Lessons:** Please monitor whether students are meeting their weekly expectations:
  - At least **three lessons passed per week**
  - Adequate weekly minutes for both reading and math
  - Passing rates that reflect understanding, not guessing or rushing
- Consistent monitoring ensures that I-Ready remains an effective instructional tool and that we are meeting every scholar exactly where they are.

**Classwise is Here**

The District is preparing to roll out the new Linewize and Classwise applications. These tools will replace many of the same classroom management features we previously had in Lanschool, which the District has discontinued.

Elementary schools are included in the next phase of the rollout. More information will be shared once access becomes available.

Classwise is now available for teacher use. This powerful tool supports classroom technology management by allowing teachers to:

- Turn specific websites **on or off** for students
- Monitor student activity in real time
- Broadcast announcements directly to student devices
- Access many additional classroom management features designed to keep students focused and on-task
