









### **Call to Order**

The Coral Springs Elementary School Advisory Forum (SAF) meeting was called to order at **6:00 PM** by **SAF Chair Ms. Sandoval**. Ms. Sandoval welcomed parents, staff members, and community stakeholders to the meeting.

### **Welcome and Introductions**

Attendees introduced themselves and shared their role within the Coral Springs Elementary community. The SAF Chair thanked participants for their continued engagement in school and district discussions.

### **North Area Advisory Council Updates**

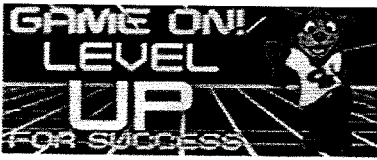
Updates from the North Area Advisory Council meeting held on January 15, 2026 were shared with attendees.

District leadership provided an overview of **Progress Monitoring 2 (PM2) testing results**, indicating that overall data trends show improvement compared to previous years. Several schools reported PM2 results that were equal to or higher than the previous year's PM3 results, demonstrating positive academic momentum across the region. The district continues to focus on improving student achievement with the goal of eliminating all "C" rated schools.

At the elementary level, schools are using PM2 data to guide instructional planning for the remainder of the school year. Teachers and instructional leaders are conducting detailed student-by-student data reviews to ensure that individual student needs are addressed. Interventions include classroom instruction, push-in and pull-out support, and additional services provided through ESE, gifted programs, and targeted interventions. Parent engagement strategies such as literacy nights, conferences, and sharing student progress data were also discussed as ways to support student success.

Parents also raised questions during the advisory meeting regarding how to interpret testing results for younger students. District leaders explained that some assessments may measure content that has not yet been fully taught, which can cause lower scores. Schools were encouraged to support families in understanding how to interpret assessment data and student progress reports.



### **District Operational Updates**

The advisory council also discussed district decisions related to **graduation ceremony venues** for high schools. Due to cost-saving measures, some ceremonies will be moved from large external venues to school-based locations such as gymnasiums. While this issue primarily affects secondary schools, the discussion highlighted broader district financial considerations and community concerns regarding budget priorities.

Members also discussed the district's **hiring freeze** and how staffing vacancies are being addressed. District leadership indicated that staffing needs are reviewed regularly and that certified district staff may be temporarily assigned to schools to help cover vacancies when possible. These decisions are influenced by factors such as declining enrollment and potential school consolidation considerations.

### **District Advisory Updates**

Additional updates were provided regarding upcoming district initiatives. The School Board plans to hold a **workshop in February related to testing platforms and student performance data systems**.

Discussion also included updates on **School Advisory Council (SAC) funding**, though no additional information regarding funding allocations was available at the time of the meeting. Principals were encouraged to communicate school needs directly to district leadership.

Members also noted continued conversations regarding **school nurse staffing**, district redefining discussions, and updates from Food and Nutrition Services regarding student lunch balance payments. Families who wish to make payments toward lunch balances were advised to work directly with their school's cafeteria manager.

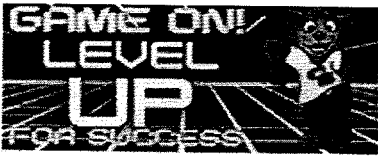
Updates specific to Coral Springs Elementary were shared regarding school programs, instructional initiatives, and opportunities for parent involvement.
