

Call to Order

The meeting of the Coral Springs Elementary School Advisory Council (SAC) was called to order at 6:08 p.m. by Yvette Sandoval and Lindsay Shridat.

II. Review of Minutes

- Yvette Sandoval read the minutes from the previous meeting.
- A motion to approve the February 2026 minutes was made by Ms. Ambroise and seconded by Ms. Gordon.
- The motion carried unanimously.



III. Principal's Report

Ms. Fulton reported the following:

- On March 3, the school received notification that ESE students are showing improvement in I-Ready Math and Reading. Coral Springs Elementary is currently ranked #2 in the district overall and tied for 5th place for ESE student performance.
- Students will participate in the I-Ready diagnostic assessment next week. This assessment is not tied to district testing requirements.
- The school currently has vacancies in 2nd grade. As a result, the grade level has been divided into two classes with approximately 29 students each. Two ESE paraprofessionals will assist in supporting the classrooms.
- A 1st grade teacher will be going on leave after Spring Break. Ms. Payne will temporarily cover the class, and the district will assign a substitute to cover Ms. Payne's position.
- Ms. Rucker reported that there were no SESIR incidents in February 2026.

IV. Accountability Funds

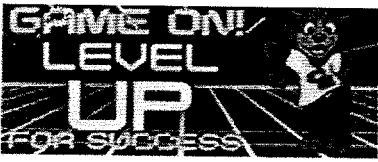
- Current Balance: \$19,111.23
- Ms. Fulton proposed allocating \$9,000.00 to purchase and install a screen projector for the cafeteria.
- A vote was conducted and the proposal passed unanimously (10 yes, 0 no).

V. Title I Updates

- Ms. Gordon reviewed the results of the Parent Survey. A total of 37 responses were received, indicating strong communication and high levels of parent involvement.
- Ms. Gordon also shared additional information regarding the 2026–2027 School Improvement Plan (SIP).

VI. SAF Updates

- Ms. Sandoval updated the SAC members of the districts SAF meeting:
Accountability Funds Update:
The committee was informed that during the most recent North Area Advisory meeting, a motion had previously been passed requesting the district provide clearer guidance to principals and SAC chairs regarding the use of Accountability



Funds. An update shared by district leadership indicated that the Superintendent is currently working with the Chief Financial Officer (CFO) to determine whether Accountability Funds will be permitted to roll over. Allowing these funds to carry over is important, as the state vetoed these funds in 2021 and schools have not received additional funding since that time. These funds are commonly used to support School Improvement Plan (SIP) initiatives and programs such as ELO camps and SAT preparation. Additional updates will be shared once the item is brought before the School Board for further discussion.
