Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at **5:25 PM**.

1. Approval of Previous Minutes

- The **December SAC meeting minutes** were reviewed.
 - Approval of the December minutes was **tabled** and will be addressed at the next meeting.

2. Alyssa's Alert / See Something, Say Something / Florida Fortify

- There are **no new updates** at this time.

3. Title I Updates

- The school is currently in the process of **scheduling Curriculum Nights**.
 - Families will be notified once dates and times have been finalized.

4. Magnet Program Updates

- Ms. Lendick and Ms. Artanis shared that **Bair Middle School will reopen for the 2026–2027 school year** and has received the **green light to begin recruitment**.
- Ms. Lendick is working on the **master schedule** in collaboration with the scheduling committee, including:
 - Transitioning to a **block schedule**
 - Developing **new elective offerings** for the upcoming school year

- A future **parent information event** will be scheduled to share these updates.

5. Department Updates

- All departments are currently conducting **data chats**.
 - Departments have developed **Crunch Time Action Plans** as the school prepares for **PM3**.

6. Guidance Updates

- **Honor Roll** is scheduled for **February 4**.
 - The guidance team is actively working on:
 - **Credit recovery**
 - Planning and scheduling events for **incoming 6th grade students**
 - Collaborating with high schools to support **8th grade students transitioning to high school**
 - The team will continue to partner with Ms. Lendick on scheduling and planning.

7. ESE / ELL Department Updates

- The ESE/ELL team is preparing for **FTE compliance** and is making **strong progress**.

8. Principal's Report

- Mr. Williams provided an update on Bair Middle School, including the **School Board's final 5-4 vote** that resulted in the school being **saved**.
- This outcome reflects the impact of **collective advocacy and collaboration**.
- Mr. Williams emphasized that while this milestone is significant, **important work lies ahead**.

Amazon Future Engineer Program Discussion:

- Ms. Allen asked questions regarding how the program functions and how it impacts the **school grade**.
- Ms. Lendick explained:
 - Acceleration data from **industry certification exams lags by one year** and impacts the following school year.
 - **EOC results** (Algebra, Geometry, Biology) do **not lag**.
 - Each student may only count **once per school year** toward middle school acceleration.
 - Students may attempt industry certification exams multiple times; **only one passing score is required** to count in the numerator.

Assessment Data Summary:

- **Device Configuration and Management**
 - 43 tests given
 - 25 tests passed (58%)
- **Python**
 - 54 tests given
 - 9 tests passed (17%)
- **Total**
 - 97 tests given
 - 34 tests passed (35%)
- **49 students** took at least one test:
 - 20 passed on the first attempt (41%)
 - 14 passed on a repeated attempt (29%)
 - 15 did not pass any attempts (31%)
 - Of these 15 students, **13 failed on three separate attempts**
- Overall acceleration pass rate:
34 of 49 students passed at least one assessment (69%)

Hypothetical Scenarios for Improvement:

- If 6 of 13 triple-fail students passed: **40/49 (82%)**
 - If 6 of 13 triple-fail students did not test: **34/42 (81%)**
 - If all 13 triple-fail students did not test: **34/36 (94%)**
 - Bair currently sits at **69% acceleration for 2026**, based on lagging 2025 industry certification results.
 - Industry certification positively impacts school acceleration **only if its pass rate exceeds that of EOC assessments.**
