1. Welcome & Call to Order
 - Meeting called to order at 8:05 am by SAC Chair Jacqueline Pabon
2. Unfinished Business
 - a. Approval of Minutes
 - No quorum at start of meeting. Not enough members are present to approve minutes. Quorum is available at 8:15 am. Motion to approve December Meeting Minutes. No feedback provided. None opposed. Motion approved
3. School Improvement Plan (SIP) Monitoring
 - Counseling Plan/ SEL SIP - Hilaire's accountability fund request has been approved as it is the same amount requested in May. The funds reflect alignment to the goals stated in our plan. The plan directly aligns to student goals and social emotional wellbeing.
4. Accountability Funds
 - \$21,496.29 funds available. After Mrs. Hilaire's quote, we have \$20,313.96.
 - 1st Quote Provided to SAC- Sanchez presented a Jack Hartman 1hr Assembly (\$2,500) with a potential date of October 28, 2026. This would be for students from HeadStart to 2nd Grade. If a date for this year becomes available for this school year, we will be told. A quote for another assembly like Jack Hartman will be found as a backup person to come out for the students this year if availability for Jack Hartman does not become available.
 - Conversation about where funds from other fundraisers are going i.e. Kona Ice. What are the funds used for? How do they impact students?
 - 2nd Quote -Principal Garrick presented promethean boards and stands in the amount of \$18,151.00 for 7. 7 Panels are \$ 2,218 and 7 stands are \$ 375.
 - Motion made by Principal to approve both quotes given that there will be a survey provided to all instructional staff members for the number of current staff with Promethean Boards and those that would like to have one.
