I. School Improvement Plan

Review/Development of School Improvement Plan (SIP) with Title 1 Addendum

*Teachers, Parents, Community input

-Parents suggested continued use of parent links.

-Staff recommended the use of parent links school-wide and class-wide.

-Parents requested continued communication through monthly newsletters.

-parents requested continued weekly principal tidbits.

- Growth Monitoring Check

- o Tutoring is happening in the morning, during specials for select students

 - It was piloted, will that system be purchased if another system is being purchased, we will inquire more about the program proposed.

 - Rollover funds removed from fund- eliminate rollover fund entirely new CFO
 - Funds wiped out without prior notice, that was used for tutoring and materials the funds were given to schools who overspent.
 - District decided how money would be sent.
 - North region SAF voiced objections and more transparency, for money to be returned to the schools “Amended motion is offered: We MOVE that the District return the Accountability Funds and SIP rollover dollars that schools had left over from previous year to the school it came from and they be afforded 120 school days or until the end of the 2025/26 school year, whichever is longer, to spend those funds - Moved by TaiQuay Bogle, 2nd by Nancy Fry. Motion passes as amended with none opposed.”
