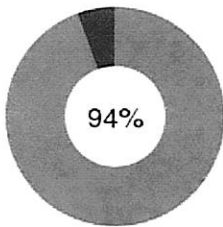

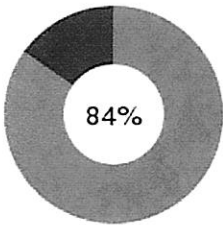

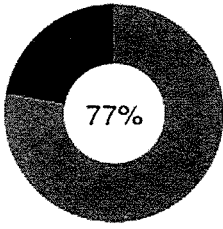

I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 8:19 AM. Members and guests were welcomed.

II. Verification of Quorum

A roll call was conducted. Quorum was met.

III. Review of October Meeting Minutes

The October minutes were reviewed.

- Motion to approve: Mr. Kirk
- Second: Mrs. Cruz
- Vote: All in favor, none opposed

The October minutes were officially approved.

IV. New Business – Florida School Recognition (A+) Funds

Mr. Kirk presented information on the \$84,488 awarded to the school through the Florida School Recognition Program. He outlined the allowable uses of funds (staff bonuses or staff recognition purchases) and explained the required SAC and staff voting process. A December meeting will be scheduled for staff proposals before SAC approval.

V. Additional Funding Sources

Three funding sources were discussed:

- Facility Rental Funds (\$40,000), which will not carry over after this year.
- SAC Accountability Funds (\$18,352), designated for SIP goals.
- A+ Recognition Funds (\$84,488).

An outdoor covered structure for the west courtyard was presented as a potential project funded through facility rental and accountability funds.

VI. 2025–2026 School Year Schedule Update

The district previously proposed a shift to a 7-period schedule due to declining enrollment and budget concerns. Following stakeholder feedback, the proposal was withdrawn.

VII. Principal's Update – Mr. Kirk

Mr. Kirk shared updates on PM2 testing, professional learning, extracurricular achievements, and PTO activities. RMS celebrated nine All-County Honor Band students, two All-County Jazz students, and strong performance across sports and clubs.

He also reminded families to monitor student social media use due to concerning online trends.

VIII. SAC Accountability Funds

Updated balance: \$18,352.82. Funds continue to support SIP goals, attendance initiatives, and teacher stipends for academic intervention support.

IX. SIP Monitoring – Mrs. Pladley

Quarter 1 attendance averaged 96%. Fun Friday on November 14 was successful, with PTO providing snacks and treats. Reward Room and attendance incentives continue to support SIP objectives.

X. Department Chair Updates

Science: Preparing for PSA assessments, increased hands-on labs, and in-house field experience planning.

Social Studies: Units on Ancient Egypt, Civics BSA prep, American Revolution content, MTL Toy Drive.

ELA: Writing units, Panther Poetry Contest, Literary Fair submissions (Dec 16–17), FAST PM2 on Dec 2.

Math: Geometry and Algebra preparing for CFAs and midterms; Virtual Reality algebra simulations; PM2 testing before winter break.

School Initiatives: The Buzz continues strong promotional work for No Place for Hate, Toy Drive, and Harvest Drive.

XI. Stakeholder Feedback

Stakeholders shared feedback regarding lunchtime detention supervision capacity and student behavior support. Discussion involved parents, teachers, and administration. Administration acknowledged concerns and will review potential adjustments.

I. Call to Order/Welcome

The meeting was called to order at 8:18 AM on August 18, 2025. Members were welcomed.

II. SAC Committee Roll Call

A roll call was conducted to verify quorum. 10 members present included:

With the required members present, quorum was met.

III. FI Florida School Recognition (A+ Funds) Creation of Ballot/Vote

Mr. Kirk presented information regarding the Florida School Recognition (A+) Funds.

- Ramblewood Middle School earned an A rating, qualifying the school for recognition funds.
- The total allocation for the school is \$77,604.00.
- SAC is responsible for determining how these funds are used.

Mr. Kirk reviewed allowable options for use of funds:

1. Purchase of non-consumable school-related items (e.g., equipment, supplies, technology).
2. One-time bonuses for eligible employees employed by Broward County Public Schools.

Non-allowable uses include:

- Student incentives or parties
- Consumable items such as food
- Tickets, trips, or entertainment

Mr. Kirk explained the approval process:

- SAC develops ballot options.
- Ballot must be advertised for three days.
- At least 80% of staff must vote.
- A 66⅔% majority is required for approval.
- If no agreement is reached by February 1, funds are automatically distributed evenly to eligible staff.

Based on last year's staffing levels, an estimated distribution would result in approximately \$775 per eligible employee before taxes, prorated based on length of assignment during the prior school year.

The proposed ballot was reviewed:

Option 1:

The award will be divided equally among all 2024-2025 eligible employees according to the eligibility requirements stated below. Any unused funds will be used at the principal's discretion.

Option 2:

None of the above.

Eligibility criteria included:

- Full-time employees assigned to Ramblewood Middle School during the 2024–2025 school year.
- Bonus prorated based on number of days assigned (out of 180).
- Unused funds to be used at the principal's discretion.

No additional ballot options were proposed.

A motion was made to approve Option 1 for the Florida School Recognition (A+) Funds ballot.

The SAC approved distributing the Florida School Recognition (A+) Funds equally among all eligible 2024–2025 employees according to the stated eligibility requirements. Any unused funds will be used at the principal’s discretion.
