I. Call to Order / Welcome

The meeting was called to order at 8:16 AM. Members were welcomed.

II. SAC Committee Members Roll Call

A roll call was conducted.

Members Present: Cassandra Allen, Rosaura Cruz, Dr. Sophia Haynes, Mr. Kirk, Melissa LaSalle, Vanessa Lindeman, Nicole Pladley, Karen Smith, Xandria Willingham, Karen Novak, and Erika Manzanares (11 committee members total).

Quorum was met, allowing the council to conduct official business and voting.

III. Voting to Utilize \$4,182 of A+ Funds

Mr. Kirk explained that the purpose of the special meeting was due to an upcoming budget freeze on April 15. Remaining funds must be allocated prior to this deadline.

All current-year A+ recognition funds totaling \$77,604 had already been distributed to staff. However, an additional \$4,182 from prior years was identified and must be used before being reclaimed by the district.

Proposal:

- Purchase of a Promethean Board (approximately 75-inch model)
- Purchase of a stand for the board
- Purchase of electronic supplies (e.g., HDMI cables)
- Remaining funds to be used for paper

The proposal aligns with School Improvement Plan (SIP) goals and supports classroom technology upgrades.

Additional Context:

- Additional Promethean boards will be purchased using facility rental and before/aftercare funds.
- The long-term goal is to equip all classrooms with updated instructional technology.

Motion to vote: Vanessa Lindeman

Second: Motion was seconded by Rosaura Cruz

A roll-call vote was conducted with all members voting in favor.

Result: The motion passed unanimously. The SAC approved the use of \$4,182 in A+ funds for the proposed purchases.




