- ii. Approval of May 2025 Minutes – motion to approve Mr. Mankes, Second by Mrs. Clarke
- iii. SAC Composition and SAC/SAF By-Laws – Ms. Tesch reviewed SAC/SAF by-laws. Everyone agreed.
- iv. Collection Development Plan
  - plan completed earlier this year
  - 10 items per student required, Ramblewood has 12.2 items per students
  - working on grants to create STEM space
  - parents are allowed to opt-out of checking out books

- v. Review SIP – everything has been uploaded for this year's SIP plan
- vi. Review Title1 Addendum
  - Mrs. Lopez, the new science coach this year is our Title One liaison. She has a science training today and is unable to be with us. Any questions after reviewing the addendum reach out to Mrs. Ibarrodo.
- vii. PBIS Plan
  - Students at Ramblewood overall maintain positive and safe behavior
  - 27 instances of unruly and disruptive behavior
  - 9 instances of physical attacks reported last year
  - 4 instances of mistreatment of peers
  - 4 instances of disobedience or insubordination

- 3 instances of inappropriate use of technology
- Ramblewood 5 is a schoolwide expectation
- Behavior assemblies took place already for all grade levels
- Mrs. Dodge, school counselor promotes positive behavior with resiliency lessons and character education

viii. Cognia Survey Results

- Parent concern Low area on our survey school was having a parent resource center for families. Currently setting up an old classroom as a family resource center.
- Staff felt our school does not implement changes based on the feedback of the staff or enjoy cafeteria food.
- 48 % of students felt the school was clean and well-maintained, 51% felt that peers treat each other with respect, 44% enjoyed

eating food from the cafeteria 28% teachers  
ask what they think about school

ix. Accountability Funds \$14,500

x. School Data –

- Last year's reading data: kindergarten 58% proficiency, 1<sup>st</sup> grade 65% proficiency, 2<sup>nd</sup> grade 61%, 3<sup>rd</sup> 68% proficiency, 4<sup>th</sup> grade 61%, 5<sup>th</sup> grade 63%
- Current reading data: kindergarten 13% proficiency, 1<sup>st</sup> grade 17% proficiency, 2<sup>nd</sup> grade 30% proficiency, 3<sup>rd</sup> grade 24% proficiency, 4<sup>th</sup> grade 34% proficiency, 5<sup>th</sup> grade 41% proficiency
- Action plan for reading – developing more professional development opportunities for staff, scope and sequence being followed with fidelity, specials supporting teachers
- Last year's math data: kindergarten 47% proficiency, first grade 65% proficiency,

second grade 66% proficiency, 3<sup>rd</sup> grade 70% proficiency, 4<sup>th</sup> grade 77% proficiency, 66% proficiency for fifth grade

- Current math data: 0% proficiency in kindergarten, first grade 15% proficiency, second 23% proficiency, 11% proficiency in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, 21% proficiency in fourth grade, 18% proficiency in fifth grade
- Action steps- use district support strategies learned last year, developing more professional development opportunities for staff, scope and sequence being followed with fidelity

- xii. School Safety – school does not have SRO, we have Guardian Fernandez, he has been very helpful so far and the school is happy to welcome.
