Call to Order:

A meeting of the Maplewood School Advisory Council was held at Maplewood Elementary School on September 25, 2025. Erika Bretz called the meeting to order at 2:36 PM. Alan Jablonowitz motions to approve, Kimberly Horman second it. Maria Castranovo will record minutes for this meeting.

Minutes:

Erika Bretz motioned to approve the May minutes. Alan Jablonowitz motions to approve, Kimberly Horman second it.

School Improvement Plan – (Bretz)

Mrs. Bretz described what SAC committee meeting is what the role of it is for the school.

- o Ms. Bretz explained what SAF is and how fortunate it is to have Kimberly Horman and Rose Heinen. They will attend the SAF meetings and bring back the information to share with us. We will have two SAC/SAF combined meetings this year.
- o SAC is the voice of the parents and other skilled professionals with different views every month we review the SIP Plan.
- o SIP plan is very data driven plan and is up and running. It is used as a guide just like how we do with the student data. It at student behavior, identify and monitor school needs, progress monitoring and gathering feedback.
- o We had a very good year last year with a 19% gain in science.
- o The role of SAC is to monitor the improvement plan, get grade level updates, extended learning, home school connections, student achievement, school progress, and students learning outcome.
- o The SAC committee is made up of the principal, teachers, school staff, parents, and community. We need to vote for ESE, ESOL, Pre-K, Gifted parent representatives. We will do this later in the meeting.
- o By law, we state that every three years we need to vote for a chair and secretary which will be done this May by all voting members.

Safety Updates – (Godoy)

- o We are a safe school. There is lot of information on the Maplewood website – attendance, SAC, and other information. The state has been out already to check on our safety. Officer Guard our resource officer has been out and will return in November. We have had a Broward County Guardian at school each day he has been out. We have new Centegix badges. If any staff member needs any help, they press the button three times, and it notifies the

school responders to who needs help and where they are located. If any staff feels that the school is in danger, they can continuously hit the button which would put the school on immediate lockdown and contact law enforcement. All safe space logos have been redone based on the area that the teachers use for their secure location which is usually their closets. All students need to take each drill very seriously and need to pay attention to all adults in the building. We have a single point of entry which every person all staff members need to use every time they enter and exit the building.

SESIR – (Godoy)

- School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR) - There have been no SESIR incidents at Maplewood Elementary. This is the biggest infraction we have had this year is a student biting incident. This year the behavior matrix is a little stricter based on each grade level. Please remember to talk with your children about how to deal with frustration because that is when we see more incidents. The state has said that this will go on their student record and not come off when there is a BTIP infraction. Referrals are now on FOCUS.

Title I Updates – (Orr for Scott)

- Purpose of Federal Funding – student activities, provide a well-rounded education across multiple subjects, funds both instructional and non-instructional support services, improve overall school quality and student outcome, and ensure compliance with federal spending provisions.
- It is based on the number of students who apply for free and reduced lunch. So, 46% of families have applied. Please remind everyone to apply.

Principal's Report: (Orr)

- We have tornado drills twice a year one now and one in February.
- Please wear white for Peace Day
- October is fire safety month. Students will be making posters for the Coral Springs Fire Department in art class with Mrs. Garcia.
- Fun family day – all are invited to be on the committee to plan this event.
- The county came out to spray mosquitoes.
- K-1 drop off – too many students arriving 7:50-8:00

School Advisor Committee Vote: (Bretz)

- Each representative from each category that needed a representative for this school year had a chance to introduce themselves and tell what class their child was in. The areas that needed representatives were Pre-K – Jondria Thompson was only one running, she is new pre-k representative, ESE - Savanna Maldonado, Kristen Beer, and Amy Beshir were running, Kristen Beer is the new representative, ELL – Siryeveli Bonilla was only one running, she is the new ELL representative.
