

### Call to Order:

A meeting of the Maplewood School Advisory Council was held at Maplewood Elementary School on November 4, 2024. SAC Chair, Erika Bretz, called the meeting to order at 2:30 PM. Alan Jablonowitz approved motion and Kim Horman second. Maria Castranovo will record the minutes.

**Roll Call SAC/SAF Members:** Ms. Castranovo did the roll call, all members were present.

### Review and Approve SAC Minutes for September:

Ms. Bretz motioned to approve of the September minutes. Alan Jablonowitz motions to approve, Kim Horman second.

### SAC Membership

- Mrs. Bretz reviewed SAC members. We are still in need of filling the role for gifted parent representative.

### School Improvement Plan – (Bretz and Castranovo)

- Maplewood Math and Reading Professional Learning Community: Question 1: What do we expect students to learn? Review Power standards and Benchmark Assessments, Write SMART Goal - Action Plan and Common Assessments, TEACH – Check for progress along the way (formative assessment), Give Common Assessment – Analyze results (Question 2: How do we know if the students have learned?), and Collective Inquiry – Turn insights into actions (questions 3 and 4 what we do if they don't learn? What will we do if they already know it?).
- Maplewood Assessments: i-Ready Diagnostic, Star Reading and Star Literacy K to 2, FAST – Grades 3 to 5, Benchmark, and Envision

### Safety Updates – (Godoy)

- Maplewood's Commitment to safety and security – The safety and security of our students, staff, and visitors remain our top priority. We are continually working to enhance safety protocols and security measures. We are focused on creating safe, supportive learning environment for all members of our school community.

### SESIR – (Godoy)

- No incidents to report. We have had a Guardian since Office Guard has been out. Office Guard will be at Trunk or Treat. We is expected to return back to us on November 3.

### **School Accountability Funds – (Bretz)**

- Mrs. Orr will discuss this in her principal's update.

### **Title I Updates – (Scott)**

- Purpose of Federal Funds: support a wide range of activities to help students meet state academic standards, provide a well-rounded education across multiple subjects, fund both instructional and non-instructional support services, improve overall school quality and student outcome, and ensure compliance with federal spending provisions for effective, efficient use of resources.

### **Principal's Report – (Orr)**

- Accountability funds – there was a meeting last week where SAF and Principals were told that they were taking all accountability funds and left over A+ money that was left over from last school year to give to schools who were in the red. Our SAF President Mrs. Heinen was very vocal about this not happening and how it was wrong. The COF and other upper school management seemed to listen as there were rumors of the money being returned. She would find out more on 10/28 because there had been an emergency principal meeting put on all principals' schedules.
- We hosted a principal meeting at Maplewood for Coral Springs and Parkland principals (about 15) today. They walked around to classrooms and saw all the great things we are doing here at Maplewood. It was a good meeting with great feedback.
- Students are to wear red to school to kick off Red Ribbon Week.
- We will have our character parade on Friday, October 31.
- We would like to have some SAC meetings virtual and some face to face. It was discussed the pros and cons. We voted that we would try one virtual meeting next month (November) and the December meeting will bring it back to the table to see if this is something we will continue to do. A vote was taken and majority said yes for a virtual meeting in November.
