

**Davie Elementary School

September 25, 2025 - Minutes

1. Call to Order

- The meeting was called to order at 7:48 p.m.

2. Motions

- Mr. Nazario stepped down as 2024/2025 SAC Chair.
- A motion was made to approve Mrs. Arencibia and Mr. Lubin as co-chairs.
- The motion was approved by Ms. Graber, seconded by Ms. Collins.
- Mrs. Nazario distributed the May 2025 meeting minutes. The minutes were read, and a motion to approve was made by Mrs. McGhee and seconded by Mrs. Byers. Principal Collins welcomed the new co-chairs.
- Mrs. Arencibia welcomed those in attendance and introduced herself.

3. Principal's Report

- Principal Collins reported that there are currently zero SESIR incidents. She noted that accountability funds will roll over by November. The School Improvement Plan (SIP) has been submitted, with this year's focus on moving students to at least 50% proficiency and ensuring each student makes at least one year's growth to help close learning gaps.
- She welcomed everyone to the September SAC meeting and the 2025–2026 school year at Davie Elementary. This year's theme is **“Trekking Through a Safari of Knowledge.”**

Principal Collins reported a smooth and safe school opening and a successful Open House. She highlighted donations received from community organizations, including over 30 computers donated to families by the Kiwanis Club.

She announced that the first in-person **Mustang of the Month** program will take place tomorrow.

4. Title I Update

- Mrs. Quintana reported that she is currently exploring parent engagement event opportunities. Updates will be provided once events are scheduled.

5. Open Floor

- **School Grade & Enrollment:** A parent asked about enrollment and how close Davie Elementary is to becoming a “B” school. Principal Collins explained that DVE is at 51%, and 54% is required to move to a “B” rating.
- **Uniforms:** A parent asked if the school will vote on uniforms this year. Principal Collins responded that a vote will likely occur in 2026.

- **Safety & Facilities:**
 - Parents expressed concerns about parking dividers and spaces at Gate 4. Principal Collins shared that work orders are being placed, and she will follow up.
 - Sidewalk cracks were repaired over the summer. Floors are the next priority for improvement.
 - Parents noted that cafeteria floors and walls appear aged. Principal Collins shared that walkthroughs included discussions of repainting the school, including the cafeteria.
- **Cafecito Program:** Mrs. Fonseca introduced Cafecito. Parents asked if participation was limited to ESOL families. Mrs. Fonseca clarified that all families are welcome.
- **Restrooms:** Parents expressed concerns about the conditions of restrooms and sinks in some classrooms. Principal Collins stated that restroom upgrades are a top priority and confirmed that Mr. Kevin is working on related work orders.

6. Adjournment

- A motion to adjourn was made at 8:18 a.m. and seconded by Mr. Lubin. The meeting was concluded.
