

SAF Updates

Last meeting 2/19/26

Hazel Health- A family health program includes Telehealth, has been cost free to the district for 5 years with no cost. On June 2026, it will not be renewed. Nothing will be taking its place.

Dr. Fleming spoke about the district hiring freeze and 1,000 layoffs. Security and teachers will be excluded from this.

Testing Schedule- Teachers and parents went in front of the Broward board of education expressing their concerns about how much testing our students are doing. The board made it clear that this conversation is not over. The District will be developing potential solutions and bringing them back to the Board in another workshop during Q3 or Q4. ALL board members want to see reduced BCPS mandatory testing and some board members expressed that they want BCPS mandatory testing completely eliminated.

Funds-The Accountability funds and recognition funds Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) has recently taken back, or "swept," unused rollover accountability funds, raising significant concerns, particularly regarding the funding of academic intervention camps. Schools have still not been given a clear answer whether funds will still rollover.
