1. **Call to order:** SAC Chair, Ms. Iliana Mejia called the meeting to order at 5:44 P.M.
2. **Introductions and Attendance:** 9 out of 17 members were present, quorum was established.
3. **Approval of Minutes:** First motion to approve January Minutes by Jordan Morgan and seconded by Judy Mobley. Minutes approved by a unanimous vote.
4. **Principal's Report:**
  - **Current enrollment:** 544 Students
  - **Vacancies: 1**
    - >Teacher Assistant Position
    - > District on a hiring freeze
  - **Accountability Funds:** \$14,370.80
  - **School Recognition Balance Carryover:** \$3,000
  - **Accountability Fund Request:** \$10,000 is being requested from the Accountability Funds to pay the salaries of teachers and supplies for ELO Camp.
    - > The motion was approved to spend \$10,000 of the Accountability Funds to pay for the salaries for the teachers and supplies for ELO Camp.
