Call meeting to order/ Attendance: A meeting of the Riverglades Elementary School Advisory Council was called to order by Stephanie Rodriguez at 9:35am. Secretary Kathleen Judd recorded the minutes. Attendance attached. The purpose of SAC is to provide you with information regarding and to develop our School Improvement Plan.

Minutes: Rodriguez summarized the September minutes. Jen Sainato made a motion to approve the September minutes. Motion outcome: Minutes from September, 2025, approved.

School Improvement Plan (SIP): Rodriguez shared what Title 1 is and encouraged anyone to try to receive free and reduced lunches because it is no longer free. Discussed Early Warning Indicators- what can we do better to try to get students in each grade level out of certain categories (like *absent 10% or more days* or *level 1 on statewide ELA assessment*). Duhart went over the School Wide Behavior plan and discussed BIG 5- Referrals by Student; Incidents of Behavior (top 5); Referrals by Date; Events by Location; Referrals by Grade Level. The report will be shared with faculty so it's clear on what incidents are happening and where. FACE Plan- Parent Welcome in Front Office. Rodriguez is setting up a "Face Place" where resources are displayed for parents/guardians. There is also a TV where events and pictures are displayed.

Accountability SAC Funds: \$9,399.62

School Environmental Safety Incident Report (SESIR): Duhart reported no updates or incidents at this time.

Principal's Report- Duhart discussed intervention groups (WIN- what I need) are underway and we are hoping for success like last year. Daily, 30-minute groups in all grade levels. Grades 3-5 do a walk to read so students are grouped by appropriate reading skills. Professional Development money is being used to pay for subs so teachers can attend PD. This month the math department is coming, next month Performance Matters is coming to discuss reports on the database and how it can be used to track data. Leader in Me- action teams have been organized so we have representation from each grade level team and we stay focused on school needs.
