Call meeting to order/ Attendance: A meeting of the Riverglades Elementary School Advisory Council was called to order by Stephanie Rodriguez at 9:35am. SAC Chair recorded the minutes. Attendance attached.

Minutes: Rodriguez summarized the minutes. Taneka Lawrence made a motion to approve the minutes. Motion outcome: Minutes from February approved.

School Improvement Plan (SIP): Rodriguez shared the SIP. School Information- Riverglades is not an ESSA School. The definition of ESSA Schools was shared. High Quality Instruction- Self Assessment (SAM) of Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS). The highest domain in the SAM was leadership. The domain that needs improvement in the SAM was Data Evaluation. Riverglades MTSS team has established specific dates where data is analyzed student by student after specific assessments have been administered. Riverglades will continue to have a strong leadership as the Leader in Me program is embedded throughout the school culture. Safe and Supportive Environment- MTSS Action Plan. Communication and Collaboration among team members through a consensus MTSS Implementation, engagement of families in MTSS was identified as an area of improvement. Data Evaluation involving data sources that impact MTSS, consistency and accuracy of data collected were identified as areas of improvement. Effective Communication- BCPS Customer Survey links were shared. The parent survey will be sent out via parent link and all parent communication outlets used by teachers.

Principal's Report- Duhart shared the principal's report. The intent to return to Riverglades Survey is out already. This helps administrators plan for the 2026-2027 school year.
