Call meeting to order/ Attendance: A meeting of the Riverglades Elementary School Advisory Council was called to order by Stephanie Rodriguez at 9:34am. Secretary Kathleen Judd recorded the minutes. Attendance attached.

Minutes: Rodriguez summarized the March, 2026 minutes. Kathleen Judd made a motion to approve the March minutes. Motion outcome: Minutes from March, 2026 approved.

School Improvement Plan (SIP): Rodriguez shared information about the Florida School Report Card, which provides an overview of school performance, including grades across various categories. For SIP purposes, the Achievement section is especially important, as it highlights overall performance levels in specific subject areas. This section also allows comparisons between Riverglades, other Broward schools, and the state level. The report card can be accessed through the Florida Department of Education website and our SIP plan. Rodriguez also referenced School Best Practices for Inclusive Education (BPIE) which our ESE specialist Jennifer Brodsky is in charge of, noting that Element #33 was identified. The purpose of BPIE is a structure assessment process designed to help schools identify priority needs, develop short-term and long-term improvement strategies and organize resources to support the implementation of inclusive practices school wide. This complies with Florida Statute 1003.57(1)(f) which mandates that every school and school district complete the process every three years. As stated before, #33 was noted as our focus. This element focuses on strengthening team meetings and PLCs, as well as improving communication with grade-level representatives to ensure consistent, schoolwide messaging and collaboration.

Additionally, it was shared that we have not yet reached our participation goal for the BCPS Customer Survey, so staff are encouraged to complete it as soon as possible.

School Environmental Safety Incident Report (SESIR): No updates

Principal's Report- Mrs. Seltzer reported that the school budget has not yet been finalized. She also shared that several after-school camps are currently underway, including Science, Reading, and Math, each meeting once a week. As we approach the end of the school year, end-of-year assessments are also coming up.
