- I. Roll Call to establish Quorum -10 members were in attendance
- II. Review & Approve Minutes from September Meeting
 - A. Amy Edelman motioned to approve, Nick Prusinowski seconded the motion
- III. School Improvement Plan-Monitoring and Feedback
 - A. Presentation of Library Plan - Michelle Bianco
 - B. The plan is based on the monetary amount per student (\$9.60 per student). She purchases books to replace old books or for new interests and to meet the needs based on our demographics. She has a 3 year plan, and updated the plan from last year. She outlined areas of strengths and weaknesses. Last year, we won the Golden Award (based on the different things our program has to offer).
 - C. The plan will be published on the school's website and she can make copies.
 - D. Discussed with shareholders that teachers are continuing following the county pacing. We were on track and currently testing on Unit 2 in Benchmark Advanced and Topic 5 in Math.
 1. Students that showed deficiencies would then be remediated during small group instruction to help close the gaps.
 2. We discussed how we looked at who was scoring 70% or above-showing proficiency. Any scoring lower, we addressed their needs.
 3. We discussed this was an ongoing process for all tests that students took.
