- I. Roll Call to establish Quorum
 - A. Quorum is established
- II. Review & Approve Minutes from January Meeting
 - A. Bryan Braud motioned to approve, Andy Francois seconded the motion.
- III. School Improvement Plan-Monitoring and Feedback
 - A. FAST Dates
 - a. K-2 STAR ELA - April 28th
 - b. K-2 STAR MATH - April 29th
 - c. Gr. 3-5 FAST ELA - May 5th
 - d. Gr. 3-5 FAST MATH - May 12th
 - e. Gr. 5 SCIENCE - May 19th
 - B. Academic Camp Plans & Updates
 - a. Admin reports that after school camps have begun, and are going well. They meet twice a week on Monday and Wednesday.
 - b. Students in grade 3 are working on reading. Students in grades 4 and 5 focus one day on reading, and one day on math.
 - c. New plan to start Science camp for 5th graders starting in March- while our MOY data shows growth- camp should help with even more. Fifth grade gre from 48% BOY to 63% MOY
- IV. Accountability Funds –\$11861.50
 - A. \$6000 not taken out yet for Academic Camps but was already approved
 - B. Additional Funds being requested for a Grade 5 Science Camp
 - a. Camp would begin in March
 - b. Mrs. Morgan requested \$2,000 from accountability funds to be used to cover the cost of paying teachers and materials.
 - c. Discussion on how students would be identified for an invitation to science camp. Mrs. Morgan would work with 5th grade teachers looking at Middle of Year Science data. She also recently met with the Science

Department to determine who the best candidates were to attend science camp based on recent test scores. Our goal is for 73% of our 5th graders to be at a level 3 and above on the FAST Science test.

- d. Media and Computer Specials will begin to enrich during 5th grade specials on science standards, as well.
- e. The committee voted on the use of the funds. Lisette Diaz made a motion to approve funds. Tina Bhatt seconded the motion. It was unanimously approved. The vote was as follows:

V. Principal Report

A. Updates

- a. The new fire alarm system that was installed has been finalized and is working well. It was recently tested during a brief, unexpected evacuation due to something minor in the cafeteria. Our team and local officials quickly determined there was no danger, and students were back in class within minutes.
- b. The Spring Book Fair is currently going on and is going well. Using an E-Wallet system has helped curb issues with students losing money, as well as expedite student purchases.
- c. The Kindergarten Playground was renovated and will reopen this week. This was partly funded by the school and the district.
- d. Possibly will need to use all Accountability Funds before the end of the school. Mrs. Morgan will let the SAC meeting know at the next meeting. If so, it was suggested to purchase Academic Camp materials for the next year, so we are prepared.
- e. A question was asked about enrollment and class size for the next school year. Currently, no decisions have been made because Mrs. Morgan has not received the budget for next year yet. Mrs. Morgan will present the new budget, which will determine the number of teachers the school is slated for as soon as it's available.
