- III. Roll Call to establish Quorum
 - A. Quorum is established
- IV. Review & Approve Minutes from February Meeting
 - A. Paige Hilton motioned to approve, Amy Edelman seconded the motion.
- III. School Improvement Plan-Monitoring and Feedback
 - A. Positive Behavior Plan - Ms. Brown reviewed our school's plan to the SAC team and highlighted the key points. It is also available online via the School Improvement Plan (SIP). After meeting with staff at the recent faculty meeting to discuss this year's behavior data, the consensus from all was to continue with the plan for next school year. Some highlights Ms. Brown shared were:
 - a. The plan is continually monitored and shared at the beginning of the year with all stakeholders, as well as quarterly and at faculty meetings.
 - b. The use of H.E.R.O.N. Bucks to recognize students. The letters stand for the following traits: Honest, Excellence Seekers, Responsible, Optimistic, Neighborly, and Supportive.
 - c. Students are provided with "Brag Tags" as a reward to wear on their lanyard when seen exhibiting these traits.
 - d. In the classroom, teachers explicitly teach each of these traits with lesson plans and activities that are provided for the beginning of the year, as well as after long breaks or whenever needed.
 - e. The use of guidance small groups, SAVE/Promise Club
 - f. Training with Staff is provided as needed
 - g. There was a reduction in referrals from 36 in 2024-2025 to 31 this year, with most of the incidents falling in the "Disruptive/Unruly Behavior" category.
 - h. 0 incidents SESIR activity to report
 - i. Some new additions for next year:
 - i. Talk about the Traits on morning announcements

- ii. Recognize Student of the Month on the announcements with a "Winner's Walk"

- b. K-2 STAR MATH - April 29th
- c. Gr. 3-5 FAST ELA - May 5th

C. Ms. Adams asked SAC members to let her know if they will be staying in their position for the next school year so she would know if adjustments need to be made.

D. Summer school letters were sent home with any 3rd graders who scored a level 1 on PM 2. However, once they score a level 2 or above on PM 3, they are uninvited. Summer school will be held at Flamingo Elementary, Monday - Thursday, for 5 weeks.

E. We are continuing to collect parent surveys to finalize the BCPS Parent Survey.



