- XIII. Review of Minutes from August Meeting
- XIV. School Improvement Plan
 - A. 2025-2026 SIP Planning Data Goals
 - 1. Reading:
 - a) By June 2026, proficiency in ELA STAR PM3 will increase from 68% in May 2025 to 70% in May 2026 for students for grades K-2
 - b) By June 2026, proficiency in ELA FAST PM3 will increase from 76% in May 2025 to 78% in May 2026 for students for grades 3-5
 - 2. Math:
 - a) By June 2026, the math lowest quartile learning gains on FAST PM3 will increase from 44% in May 2025 to 50% in June 2026 for grades 3-5
 - (1) Targeting small intervention groups, iReady Math program, and if a student is on Rtl for math, MDIS is used for tier 2 and iReady toolbox is used for tier 3
 - B. Presentation of Counseling Plan - Kelly Grant
 - 1. Three areas of counseling (individuals, small group, and whole group)









2. Save Promise Club - two members from each class in grades 4 and 5 meet with Mrs. Grant to find ways to make the school more inclusive

 1. ELA PM1 last year was 44% proficient, this year is 46% proficient
 2. Math PM1 last year was 24% proficient, this year is 27% proficient

- A. We usually get a raise based on what the state and district can give us. The district has not determined this yet, but the state has determined that every teacher gets a 0.55% raise.
