**Wednesday, December 8, 2025**

Date: December 8, 2025

Time: 4:10 PM

Location: Dinner Theater

The meeting was called to order promptly at 4:10 PM by the chairperson.

The purpose of the meeting was to determine how to allocate A+ money. Attendance was taken to establish quorum, and quorum was met. Participants were asked to write down their suggestions, and the floor was opened for discussion. Members engaged in a constructive conversation regarding the best approach to distribute the funds fairly and effectively.

Three options were formally presented during the discussion: the first option proposed allocating seventy percent of the funds to Teachers and thirty percent to non-teachers; the second option suggested splitting the funds evenly among all staff members and the Family Counselor; and the third option recommended an eighty percent allocation to teachers and twenty percent to non-teachers.

Following the discussion, ballot options were ranked by all SAC members. After discussion, it was determined that the choices to appear on a proposed ballot would be the following:

Option 1:

70% split between all teachers from the 2024-2025 school year.

30% split between all non-teachers from the 2024-2025 school year.

Option 2:

100% split evenly between all staff, including the Family Counselor, from the 2024-2025 school year.

Option 3:

None of the above
