- c. Underclass Events: students need to fill out exemption forms by 5/23 at 2:45; Mandatory Reproductive Health Lessons Taught through Science on May 27 & 28; No backpack 5/28-6/3; Exam week 5/29-6/3
- d. Testing Results: FAST PM3 proficiency 77% (goal 76%); Algebra 1 proficiency 66%, Geometry proficiency 79% (cumulative goal 70%); US History proficiency 88%(goal 87%); Biology proficiency 89% (goal 85%)
- e. Budget- Proposed budget is presented, Actual budget may increase or decrease based on the number of students who report to school in the fall based on October FTE Survey; seats are projected to all be filled; expecting 3029 students; Total Projected Allocation: \$11,707,818; details presented via PowerPoint; Projected School Accountability Funds for 2025 – 2026: \$68,611.23; A+ funds will potentially be brought back up in November and SAC will offer recommendations at that time;
