Meeting Minutes

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 3:41PM

Approval of Minutes: April meeting minutes were approved.

Approval of Bylaws: Bylaws were not spoken about.

North Area Meeting update:

- Last meeting of the school year, next meeting will be after the first SAC meeting in the next school year.

District Advisory Council – DAC Update: - Provided an update, no questions.

- Reviewed the changes to Policy 6350:
 - Concern was raised that not all students interested in joining clubs may be able to find a sponsor.
 - It was asked whether non-school employees could lead a club; under the current policy, this is not permitted.
 - Questions came up regarding compensation—club sponsor stipends are at the discretion of the principal.
 - For clubs that raise funds but do not use them within the same year, remaining funds should carry over and stay with that club for future use.
- Referendum:
 - The referendum is scheduled for the November 3 ballot.
 - The School Board approved language stating that positions at the Director level and above will not receive funds if the referendum passes.
 - If the referendum is not approved, the district is projected to face a \$29M deficit.
 - The DAC committee approved a motion to request that the School Board implement a public dashboard showing how funds will be allocated and spent, including how the millage rate translates into increased taxes.
 - There was concern that teachers will have to pay their own health insurance if the referendum is passed

Old Business – No update
