V. Principal's Report- 3:24 Kefford begins

- a. Testing Data reviewed, 3:27- School grade 24-25 was 770/1000, up from 723 points in 23-24 A school! FAST, EOC, Graduation Rate, and Acceleration data reviewed. Note Graduation Rate is a lagging indicator, but held steady at 99%. Acceleration is also a lagging indicator but went up from 65% to 72%, the score is only calculated if/when students graduate. Data was compared with other schools in the region. Overall, 2nd highest score in the district for 24-25, 8 points (778) behind the top school. AP Scores continue to rise year over year as has enrollment numbers for AP courses. Cambridge data was reviewed, MSD had the highest AICE scores in the district. Newly added AICE courses offered at MSD were reviewed. Daily Bell Schedule was reviewed. Testing updates were reviewed, PM 1 on 9/4, Retake Math

EOC 9/9, Retake FAST 9/10, Retake Bio/USH 9/11, and more. Chronic Absenteeism is down in all grade levels, down 4.2% from prior school year. Comparative data with north regional schools reviewed. All District attendance goals were exceeded. 10-10-10 remains in place, data shows the policy is working, and the district is copying the practice at other schools. Homecoming football game 9/26 @ MSD vs Boca High 6 pm and dance 9/27 @ Westin Ft. Lauderdale Beach 7-11. AP Rob Johnson has moved on to another school in Palm Beach, his job as been posted.
