- a. School Improvement Plan (SIP): Review of SIP goals- 3:32 Van Tassel
 - i. AICE Enrollment boost, hoping to maintain our district leading pass rate, State funds have not been allocated to the school by the district yet given fund earned via 24-25 year test results
 - ii. AICE/AP Social Studies goal is to push pass rate up to 75%, Mrs. David outlines supplemental tutoring session offered to students
 - iii. US History goal is to push pass rate from 63% to 64% for specifically students in Regular US History class, excluding Honors and AP student pass rate data
 - iv. Science goal is to push Bio EOC pass rate from 89% to 93%
 - v. ELA goal is to push FAST proficiency from 77% to 79%
 - vi. Math goal is to push Algebra 1 and Geometry pass rates from 75% to 76%, hoping that Delta Math is relicensed by the district for granting access back to the school.
