




Now here's the latest from our PTO crew:

 - Attendance- quorum is met, 21/35 members present

 - Congrats to Jeffrey Garfield for graduating from Propel program
 - Approval of meeting minutes-November 17, 2025
 - Motion to approve made by: Lucie Spiewak

- SIP Funds-\$20,018
 - Mrs. Balint discussed allocating funds for academic camps and proposed setting aside up to \$10,000 this year. Last year, academic camps cost \$8,900. This year we want to include more grade levels and have more teachers. It will be \$50/hr. Students will attend camp for 1 hour. Teachers will work from 2:15- 3:30.
 - Motion made by Lisa Balint to set aside up \$10,000 out of the SIP funds for this year's academic camps. Broken down by:
 - 2nd: ELA
 - 3rd and 4th: ELA/ Math
 - 5th: ELA/ Math/ Science
 - Second by: Cheryl Strach
 - All in favor, none opposed.
- Accountability Funds-\$2,956
- Florida School Recognition Program (A+ Funds) Proposals

-Deirdre Bernhardt shared a presentation regarding A+ funds information.

- Award amounted to \$52,661. More schools qualified this year. Funds are from one pot so less is distributed.
- Proposals- voting must be completed by 2/1/26. All awarded funds encouraged to be spent by the end of 25/26 school year.
- As needed, emergency meeting will be January 12 to reconvene and create a new proposal with a new vote.
- Ballot creation= Must have none of the above as an option.
- Proposals must be specific. Previous proposals were shared to help brainstorm ideas for current proposal.

A+ Funds Proposals

Members had discussion regarding Reflex Math that is currently being used.
Proposal

- set 10% aside for Reflex Math (PTO request) online program for Math fluency and allocate the remainder 90% to 24-25 faculty/ staff who worked 60% of the school year. (Approximately \$6,000 cost. It is a one-year program. It will be used for grades 1-5).

Data was not available at this time to show student growth using this program.

Kati Bernard made a motion to take this proposal off the ballot since it is an additional computer program. We already have computer programs available and classroom time is limited. Meghan Smith seconded the motion.

*By a hand vote, this proposal is taken off the ballot. All approved. None opposed.

Dovena Lazaridis wondered if merit-based pay was a possibility.

Proposal #1

- Distribute 100% of funds as a one-time bonus to the 24-25 staff/faculty who worked 60% of the school year.

Lisa Balint suggested using some of the money towards Extended Learning Opportunity camps for the next school year (2026-2027)

Proposal #2

- Allocate 10% for academic learning camps and 90% one-time bonus for 24-25 faculty and staff who worked 60% of the school year.

Meghan Smith wondered if there was data to show student growth after camps were held.

Proposal #3

- None of the above

Deirdre Bernhardt gave information regarding staff roster from 2024-2025

- 82 on staff roster from 24-25
- 99 days= 60% (Social worker, school psychologist, ESE counselor (60% last school year, 100% this school year.).
- SAC members voted on either proposal 1 or proposal 2 to be included on the ballot:
- Results:
 - 11 SAC members voted for Proposal #1
 - 10 SAC members voted for Proposal #2
 - The committee voted 11-10 on the following proposal to present to faculty/staff to vote:
 - Distribute 100% of funds as a one-time bonus to the 24-25 staff/faculty who worked 60% of the school year.
 - None of the above.
 - Desiree Ramirez made a motion to approve the ballot.
 - Matthew Meyer seconded the motion
 - Voting will take place over two full days on 12/19 and 1/5.
