- School Improvement Plan (SIP)
  - Working document at this time with more information to come at an upcoming meeting.
  - Goals for the SIP will be for ELA 76% proficiency on FAST PM3 and STAR
    - Use of interventions such as iReady, small group instruction, and supplemental materials
- SIP Funds-\$11,965 Accountability Funds-\$5,532.09

More money may be coming in. Last year we found out in October. Looking at purchasing iReady toolbox with some funds this year as only transformation and state schools are getting funded for this by the district.
