- SAC Bylaws
 - Each year we review bylaws
 - Article 4 changed the word “officers” to “co-chairs”
 - Moved first meeting of the year from August to September
 - Motion to make the vote: Lucie DiCapua
 - All in favor vote: unanimous (24)
- School Improvement Plan (SIP)
 - Goals
 - ELA focus for the school year. We still teach all curriculum.
 - By June 3, 2025, 76% of students will be proficient in ELA as determined by FAST PM 3 scores.
 - Monitor through iReady diagnostic, iReady growth, FAST PM1 and PM2, STAR assessments
 - Intervention by grade level with specific skills being taught. Students can move in and out of groups based on their achievement in their intervention groups.
 - PLC (Professional Learning Community) meetings will focus on writing in all grade levels.
- SIP Funds-\$11,965
Accountability Funds-\$5,532.09
Funds have not been used but are able to be used as needed throughout the year.
- Principal’s Report
 - FAST PM1 results
 - K and 1st Early Literacy 19% level 3 or above
 - 2nd 39% level 3 or above
 - Math K-2 is at 8% proficiency
 - 36% ELA proficiency 3rd-5th
 - 46% math proficiency 3rd – 5th
 - FLDOE website
 - Riverside is an A for all subgroups last year meaning all subgroups at our school scored at a level A
 - Kids of Character

- One student a month per class to be Kid of Character
 - Student and parents will be invited to a ceremony where student will receive award and be celebrated
- Assistant Principal's Report
 - Discipline
 - Help your child understand appropriate language rather than things that would cause concern.
 - Attendance
 - In order to stay an A for All we need to make sure our students are here on time every day ready to learn.
 - Tardy students is an area of concern. When students are late, the minutes accumulate. Example: late by 10 minutes each day your child has now missed 50 minutes of school each week.
 - Chronic absenteeism: 10% of school year. That equates missing a 18 days of school throughout the year.
 - Severe chronic absenteeism is 15% of school year.
 - Last year we were at 1.2% of students who were severe chronic. (approximately 8 students)
 - Tips to help:
 - Have a back-up plan
 - Attendance line saved in your phone
