### Call to Order:

A meeting of the Coral Park Elementary School Advisory Council was held in the media center December 10, 2025

Principal Camille Pontillo called the meeting to order at 7:20. Laura Worthington recorded the minutes for this meeting.

### Minutes:

November's minutes were reviewed. A motion was made to approve the November minutes with no corrections, and the motion was seconded. A vote was taken by a show of hands of SAC members in attendance and the minutes were approved.

### Treasury Report:

\$14,048.30

### New Business:

1. Explanation of the process on how Coral Park can use the school's awarded funds of \$35,778 from the Florida School Recognition Program was given by Ms. Pontillo. Ms. Pontillo discussed the school's recognition (A+) funds and the requirements regarding how the money can be used and how the ballot creation and voting process works. An example ballot from the previous year was shown to the committee. Mrs. Lugassi then explained how our school has voted in the past and the different options on how the ballot can be created, such as equal distribution of the funds vs. a tiered system. It was also explained to the committee that if an agreement could not be reached by February 1<sup>st</sup>, the funds would be equally distributed to all current classroom teachers.

2. A ballot with the two options to equally split the funds among all 2024-2025 staff members prorated based on the percentage of time worked on their work calendar at Coral Park Elementary during the 2024-2025 school year, and the other with the choice of none of the above was proposed.
3. A motion was made by Mrs. Worthington, seconded by Mrs. Garcia to accept the ballot. The vote was unanimously accepted.
