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SAC Meeting Minutes

Wednesday, January 28, 2026, at 7:15am

Call to Order:

A meeting of the Coral Park Elementary School Advisory Council was held in the media center January 28, 2026.

Principal Camille Pontillo called the meeting to order at 7:25. Laura Worthington recorded the minutes for this meeting.

Minutes:

December's minutes were reviewed. A motion was made to approve the December minutes with no corrections, and the motion was seconded. A vote was taken by a show of hands of SAC members in attendance and the minutes were approved.

Treasury Report:

\$14,048.30 – Funds to be used for ELOs voted and approved on December 10, 2026.

New Business:

1. Mrs. Pontillo discussed the changes made to support students after students took the reading and math FAST PM2 in December and i-Ready winter diagnostic in January. Staff schedules shifted to better align support with students' needs based on progress demonstrated on these most recent assessments.
2. A+ ballot funding results were announced. Choice one, to equally split the funds among all 2024-2025 staff members prorated based on the percentage of time worked on their work calendar at Coral Park Elementary during the 2024-2025 school year, was unanimously picked by the school's staff.
3. Redefining school updates were given. Discussed the school closures happening and the possibilities of middle schools closing in

Coral Springs.

4. Discussed that on the next early release day, February 13th, we will hold a student award assembly to recognize students' academic excellence.
5. Question was asked regarding how to get access to the school's handbook. Ms. Pontillo explained that a QR code can be found in the first day packet and that it can also be found on the school's website.
6. Question was asked regarding the process of letting parents know when there is an outbreak of the flu or other health concerns. Ms. Pontillo explained that notifications are common when certain highly contagious illnesses are reported that can lead to rapid outbreaks, but that other illnesses like the flu may not be reported due to being considered a common seasonal illness.
7. SAF Updates:
 - a. School staffing of nurses was discussed, and the reason schools might have limited nurses.
 - b. School hiring freeze was discussed.
 - c. Student debts becoming student obligations was discussed, such as lunch obligations, and how this prevents children from attending field trips.
 - d. Student immigration status, specifically with parents signing up their children for free and reduced lunch. Parents are concerned about how this information could be used outside of determining assistance for purchasing student lunch.
