SAC Meeting Minutes

Wednesday, November 5, 2025, at 7:15 am

Call to Order:

A meeting of the Coral Park Elementary School Advisory Council was held in the media center November 5, 2025

Principal Camille Worthington called the meeting to order at 7:30. Laura Worthington recorded the minutes for this meeting.

Minutes:

September minutes were reviewed. Mrs. Lugassi motioned to approve the October minutes with no corrections and the motion was seconded by Mrs. Charleston. A vote was taken by a show of hands of SAC members in attendance and the minutes were approved.

New Business:

1. Ms. Lentoski presented the media center's collection plan and explained the process to the committee. Important requirements were discussed explaining that the average age of books in the school's media center must be no more than 15 years old and through this process we do currently meet this threshold.
2. Ms. Lentoski briefly brought up the district's plan regarding integration of AI "AI Tinkering" into the schools using Copilot found in Microsoft Office365. The Staff needs to be trained on how to use programs before rolling out to students. More information will be forthcoming.
3. Ms. Pontillo discussed the school's recognition (A+) funds and the requirements regarding how the money can be used and how the ballot creation and voting process works. An example ballot from the previous year was shown to the committee. Mrs. Lugassi then explained how our school has voted in the past and the different options on how the ballot can be created, such as equal distribution

of the funds vs. a tiered system. It was also explained to the committee that if an agreement could not be reached by February 1st, the funds would be equally distributed to all current classroom teachers.

4. Ms. Pontillo discussed how the students have always also been recognized for their hard work through a reward day, such as the Carnival Day theme last year.
5. Ms. Pontillo discussed the switch in the specials schedule which will start on Monday, November 10th. All students will have four specials moving forward: STEAM, Music, Media, and P.E. The specials will be on a 3-day block schedule.
6. Reviewed upcoming events. Next week Coral Park will host our annual Veteran's Day breakfast on Monday, November 10th in the media center. The first week of December we will begin the 2nd FAST Progress Monitoring for reading and math. Also, on Tuesday, December 9th Coral Park will be at the District Showcase promoting to the community all the great things happening at our school.

SAF Updates:

1. Mrs. Francis discussed the main presentation regarding Broward School's approval of a new Vape Detection for middle school students. The program is designed to curb student vaping and enhance campus safety.
2. A new district website has been launched to create a more user-friendly experience. It was developed to streamline how parents' concerns can be handled.
3. Updates were discussed regarding the district's "Redefining our Schools" initiative.
