  - c. Popcorn machine \$350

II. SIP Civics – Ms. Weller

- a. BSA 3 in March covers all standards; will be a good indicator of where we all are.
- b. After BSA 2 (January), we were 68% proficient.
- c. Goal is 72% proficient. Last year there was a big dip but this year there are 3 veteran teachers teaching civics.
- d. ELOs started this week. After school 2 times a week and pull out with Mr. La Rosa once a week for students on the bubble.
- e. Cambridge updates – current Cambridge classes offered are: English, Social Studies, Global Perspectives, Cambridge music, and Cambridge PE. We are a Cambridge for all school and use Cambridge strategies in all classes.
