Ms. Itty shared information about the procedures:

- Most schools vote for bonuses
- 123,246
- Took out fringe
- Now-113,205 divided up

Florida School Recognition Program written proposals

- Written proposals were shared
- Questions were answered
- In the past:
 - 85/15: about 1,000 per staff member
 - 15% for tutoring concern-maybe earmarked for other ideas-incentives for students, store, other principal discretion for other things
 - Any other will be at discretion of principal
 - Unclaimed-earmarked for tutoring
- How much was spent on tutoring last year-possibly 10,000-15,000 almost
 - We would first and foremost spend on tutoring and then spend on incentives if we cannot take care of it another way
 - This rolls over year to year as well as accountability fund
 - Primary focus will be the tutoring
- Do we want to do 85/15 90/10 80/20
 - Almost a 6,000 difference between 85/15 and 90/10 and about 75 per staff member
 - 15 to school tutoring and student activities

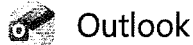
