

D. Broward Principals' & Assistant Principals' Association (BPAA) - Lisa Maxwell

- Staff positions now equate to Units
- During the Projected Budget Planning meetings- Principal input was limited or non-existent now as the district is rolling out mandates.
- No flexibility in reallocating any funds at the school level.
- Purpose of Academic Department?
 - positions should be placed in schools
 - 80 million department- 999 positions within the dept
- What are the current mandates for student- teacher ratios?
- Staffing Allocation models are changing
 - Elementary class sizes continue to increase with no plan to stabilize or reduce in the future. (Currently 28-30)
- High-level departments still remain, additional cuts in these areas would reduce the budget deficit much faster than the current approach.
- Blanket 10% reduction in enrollment across all schools. Based on lower projections than usual.
- AICE funds being cut? Staff cannot be coded to those funds.
- 34 school social worker positions maintained
- 10% or more of referendum money has been moved to salaries. There will be additional funds, but the BTU bargaining has yet to occur. If it does not pass, will result in a \$29 million deficit annually. Even if it passes, we will still maintain a deficit.
- JP Taravella recommended that the district allow the principal to make instructional staffing allocations based on funds generated by their school through Cambridge, certification funds and accelerated funds. JPT lost \$400,000. This can be handled on a spend by spend basis at this time. NADCC will put forth a motion to mirror the JPT motion.

F. Elementary Subcommittee Updates

- Accelerated Funds
- Elementary Testing

-Desire to reduce “testing”. Comprised of the assessments, checkpoints, FAST, diagnostics, etc.

H. North Region Updates

- Dr. Fleming will be moving to the South Region and will no longer attend the North Area District Advisory Meetings.
