Meeting called to order:

A meeting of the Quiet Waters Elementary School Advisory Council was held in the media center on October 27, 2025. Chair, Ashle Capron, called the meeting to order at 7:10 A.M. Tina Linn will record the minutes for the meeting.

Approval of Minutes-

1. Welcome ☺ & Approval of Minutes – Minutes were approved as is.
2. SAC Nominations
 - a. Andria Dewson Nominated Ashle Capron as SAC Chair. Rachel Rosenblum seconded the nomination. All voted yes.
 - b. Ashle Capron nominated Tina Linn as secretary. Andria Dewson seconds the nomination. All voted yes.
3. School Improvement Plan
 - a. 2025-2026 SIP Development
 - i. Review "How to Access Our School Improvement Plan"
 - ii. School Counseling & Life Skills Wellness Plan

1. Ms. Kollar and Donahue presented the plan.
 - a. Promoting Xello which is a program through canvas with self led activities for students to help figure out what their future goals are.
 - b. Lauren's Kids- Safer and Smarter month of October. Educating about kids substance use and misuse. Trusted adult week. We had kids write who their trusted adult was, either at home or at the school.
 - c. November is anti bullying month and we have activities in place to help promote.
2. Attendance Plan –
 - a. Trying to decrease the number of Chronic Absenteeism from 22.9% and severe from 11.10%. Karina Porter, is working hard with the families to understand why this is happening.
 - b. Monica Stokes has also implemented positive recognition for classrooms with good attendance.
 - c. Some students need help finding ways to get to school.
 - d. Tina Linn asked about a community form to encourage people to connect. Karina Porter also works with connecting families within the communities.

4. Principal's Sharing

- a. Title I & School Updates-
 - i. Pumpkin Patch parade on October 31
 - ii. We hired a new media clerk and she will start next week. Students will be back to checking out books.
- b. School Accountability Funds

- i. District has taken away all school accountability funds
- ii. The district also took away facilitation funds that school receives for renting out to the church.
 1. Per Andria and her SAF meeting, the district will be returning those funds and should be reflected before end of the year.

c. School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR)

5. Other Business/Open Forum

SAF Updates-

- Dr. Fleming highlighted the district's "A" rating, with 90% of North Area schools achieving A or B grades.

Vape Detection Initiative

- Vape Detection Initiative aimed at reducing student vaping and enhancing campus safety.
- The technology will be installed in middle and high schools, focusing on restrooms, with real-time alerts for administrators.
- A Q&A session addressed concerns about privacy, detector placement, and the education process for students and parents.

BCPS Cares Initiative

- New district website and the BCPS Cares initiative, which streamlines how parent concerns are addressed.
- Instead of escalating issues directly to the superintendent, parents are encouraged to follow a clear process: first contact the teacher, then the principal, and if unresolved, submit a School-Related Concern form or email the North Region office at BCPSCaresNRO@browardschools.com.

SAC Funding Changes

- It was confirmed that schools would not receive SAC rollover funds this year, leading to concerns about funding programs.
- A motion was passed to return unspent Accountability Funds and SIP rollover dollars to the originating schools, allowing them time to utilize these funds.

Redefining Update and Bylaws Subcommittee

- Upcoming meetings were announced to discuss programmatic changes and amendments to the North Area Advisory Bylaws.
- Concerns regarding the proposed Autism school and the district's response to related initiatives were raised.

SAC meeting adjournment: Meeting was adjourned at 7:45 AM
