Tequesta Trace Middle School – SAC/SAF Minutes Continuation

Meeting Summary: Mr. Flemming provided an overview of the content discussed at the previous two district meetings.

- **At the January meeting, representatives from the Food and Nutrition department delivered a presentation outlining the USDA's nutritional framework. They emphasized the use of 100% beef, the exclusion of artificial dyes, and incorporation of whole wheat products. Additionally, some schools have implemented the "shared table" initiative, allowing students to place unwanted food items in a designated area to be distributed to community organizations in need.**
- **The February meeting featured a Security Presentation delivered by the security administrator. Key topics included the Raptor system, which screens offender records and monitors district restrictions. Security staffing decisions are based on campus size, incident data, and school composition. School Resource Officers (SROs) are supported by Guardians, and Centegix alert systems for teachers are functioning as intended.**
- **The District Financial Department anticipates an enrollment decrease of 10,000 students, and ongoing budget deficits are expected to necessitate continued cost-saving measures. Ms. Baca inquired about the committee's perspectives regarding government financial vouchers. Ms. Rosario noted that Mr. Rivera has structured the school to operate efficiently, prioritizing community needs and strategic marketing efforts to attract students. His leadership approach is focused on maintaining productivity and ensuring the school's sustainability.**
- As requested, Mr. Flemming is looking into the indoor recess bill, as asked by members of the SAC committee.**
